Theta Phi Alpha Colony Closes at Marietta College

BAY VILLAGE, OH –Theta Phi Alpha is saddened to announce the closure of the Marietta College Colony in Marietta, Ohio on March 29, 2016.

Marietta College was colonized in February 2014 by a strong group of women representing the values of the Fraternity. During their time as a colony, members worked hard to make great philanthropic and social contributions to the Marietta campus and local community. However, due to sustainability challenges the Grand Council voted to close the colony.

Founded in 1912, Theta Phi Alpha is a women's organization to provide close comradeship; to advance educational, social, and philanthropic interests and leadership training; to encourage spiritual development and adherence to the highest moral standards; and to promote lifelong bonds of friendship; a fraternity for college and university women and alumnae. Theta Phi Alpha was founded at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor; today there are 56 active collegiate chapters, 34 alumnae associations and three alumnae clubs in the United States.
