BAY VILLAGE, Ohio – It is with deep regret that the Grand Council of Theta Phi Alpha announces the indefinite suspension of the charter for the Gamma Xi Chapter at The University of Virginia's College at Wise, due to national policy violations.

The Gamma Xi Chapter will forever remain a valued part of the Theta Phi Alpha sisterhood. Collegiate members of the Gamma Xi Chapter will transition to alumnae members of Theta Phi Alpha and will continue to experience a lifetime of sisterhood along with the privileges of being a lifelong member of Theta Phi Alpha.
